The central atrium, filled with natural light, is an ideal setting for drinks receptions or for socialising. Set up as a **lecture hall**, it can seat up to 80.



In addition, there is a **library** offering space for a board-room style meeting of up to 20 people, and a **dining room** (right) with seating for up to 40.



For individuals wanting a quiet break away or a place to explore, we offer comfortable, en-suite B & B accommodation. We have **11 single rooms and 13 twin rooms, for a total of 37 beds.**



Two meeting rooms. Each accommodates up to 30 people in lecture format, or 18 in a boardroom format.

The walls of the **meeting rooms** can slide away, expanding the atrium to a **lecture hall** seating up to 140 people.
