

Our unique History

Set on the gorgeous Stonyhurst Estate, in the picturesque Ribble Valley, Theodore House is a Grade II listed building previously known as the Old Mill.

Dating back to the 1840s, the site was a corn mill built by the Jesuit school after relocating to Stonyhurst Hall from St Omer, in Europe in 1794.

The Old Mill was carefully renovated by The Christian Heritage Centre at Stonyhurst - a Catholic educational charity - as a study, retreat and conference venue, winning the 2019 regional Building Excellence award from LABC.

Theodore House is an idyllic location for both peaceful B&B accommodation, as well as a flexible, ultramodern facility for conferences, events, launches, seminars, corporate away days and business meetings.
